Directions

From the North: Use US 167 or AR 7 south. N. West Avenue is Highway 167B.

From the East or West: Take Highway 82 to Highway 82B, the 167B



Parking is an important item to be aware of for this day. You need to park at Victory Church, located at 1432 N West Ave. Please fill up the parking lot staying closest to N West Ave and moving to the west. Please do not park at the Municipal Auditorium. Parking is limited, and we need to save it for our concert attendees.

In both of these situations you will be shuttled to FBC. Shuttles will begin from both lots at 12 Noon. Parking and Check-in for the Instrumentalists will be at the El Dorado Municipal Auditorium located at 100 W 8th St. Please park in the above lots after delivering all your gear and then walk to the Auditorium.

When the concert concludes everyone will have a short walk back to your vehicles from the Auditorium.


