
To date, we have these participating in Ukraine 2018:

When I brought the Ukraine trip to the group last April, I told the leadership team and the group that this could not be MY trip...it had to be OUR trip. I heard over and over...let's do it! Yes! Let's go! I have so many testimonies from people who have committed to go sharing their amazing stories of how God has provided for them to participate...provision they didn't see possible! We have a great group, but a smaller group than I expected at this point. I'm a little concerned about balance and about filling the size of rooms where we will sing. I need a few instrumental slots filled. I am committing daily to trust God that He will provide us exactly what we need, though I find myself waking up at night in Ukraine sweats! I am still praying for others to join us for this life-changing mission. Since God has told us to go to the world and make disciples, we already have our mandate to go and to serve. We usually ask God to prove to us why we SHOULD go. Let me ask you today to pray this prayer today..."God, reveal to me why I should NOT be involved in this mission." At this time, if we are able to continue to book flights at the current prices for others who join us, the trip should come in around \$2600...that's even better than we had expected. (Those who have already signed up have flights booked).




