Sometimes, the best devotional thoughts are found in old hymns. "Take Time to Be Holy" is a beloved devotional hymn written by British layman William D. Longstaff (1822-1894) and set to music by George Stebbins in 1888. The hymn text was inspired by Griffith Johns, a missionary to China, who cited 1 Peter 1:16 ("Be ye holy, for I AM holy"), which is a reference to Leviticus 11:44-45 where God instructs His children to be holy, for He is holy.

"Take time to be holy. Speak oft with thy Lord. Abide in Him always and feed on His Word. Make friends of God's children. Help those who are weak. Forgetting in nothing, His blessing to seek.

Take time to be holy. The world rushes on. Spend much time in secret with Jesus alone. By looking to Jesus, like Him thou shalt be. Thy friends in thy conduct, His likeness shall see.

Take time to be holy. Let Him be thy guide. And run not before Him whatever betide. In joy or in sorrow still follow the Lord. And looking to Jesus, still trust in His Word.
