A Matter of
Life and Breath

Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord.

Praise the Lord.

Psalm 150:6

Perhaps no other word is more often spoken in our worship or sung in our hymns than the word praise. The word most often translated praise in the Old Testament is the Hebrew word hälal. Hebrew scholar Ronald Allen tells us that "hälal is the Hebrew equivalent of whatever you say when you watching a football game and your team has just scored the winning points." Praise in the Old Testament was bold, exuberant, and loud.

Our praise should be uninhibited and unrestrained. I've heard praise defined as "enthusiastically proclaiming the unrivaled excellence of [God's] character, his name, and his actions." If we are to praise, we must pay attention as God reveals himself by working in our lives. When we see God's character revealed in his word or observe his interaction in our lives, we cannot resist praising Him with "football game" enthusiasm.

Thus praise is a matter of life and breath—breathing each breath with God and watching as he reveals himself; praising him for providing each breath; and breathing deeply, prepared for each opportunity to utter an enthusiastic shout of praise. Looking forward to enthusiastically shouting praise with you soon in Jonesboro at the state convention.

I was called into music ministry when I was 15 years old as a sophomore in high school in 2005. (I know, I know, I'm young) I was attending a concert at my home church by the University of Mobile Worship Choir and Ramcorps. I remember being enthralled with the level of musical talent I saw in the college students. The choir sang a song that was about giving yourself back to God. I remember hearing the small whisper of the Lord, "I have given you your abilities. Now use them for me." That night at the concert, I walked down the aisle and surrendered my life into music ministry.

As I began to think about this major life adjustment, I began to ponder the title "music minister." There are so many different titles for this position in churches these days: Worship Pastor, Associate of Music & Worship, Worship Leader, The Music Guy, etc. I myself tend to lean towards the title of music minister. Before I started my journey into ministry, I thought of the two separate words contained within that title. As I prayed over my own life in ministry, I asked the Lord to make me the minister before the music. We can put on the best worship services, concerts, or performances and completely miss what God has called us to as Christians. I am not saying we should look past excellence in worship music, but you cannot have ministry without people. We are called to minister to people before the music.

I challenge you to evaluate why you participate in Master'Singers. If you are like me, you love being challenged to sing or play some of the arrangements, but if the only thing you receive during our time together is a good vocal exercise then you may be missing what God has in store for you. Take time this day of Master'Singers to talk to the person next to you. You never know how you could potentially invest your life into them, and vice versa. Just try not to do it too much during rehearsals, or Larry may come after you.


