

Let Everything That Has Breath Alice Startup Women's Chorus President

It has been two and a half years since we have had a full calendar for Master'Singers and our retreat can't come quickly enough! Oh, how we have missed each other, our fellowship and laughter, but mostly the incredible music we share together!

Last week, I came across a post by Sandra Thurman Caporale that brought Master'Singers to mind. You may have already read her message or listened to a TikTok video by a young woman reading Caporale's post, but by considering the concepts she puts forth, our ministry through Master'Singers may be even more meaningful!

Most of us know that at the burning bush, Moses asked God to reveal His name and God said His name is YHWH. We also understand that YHWH means life or breath, and that in Genesis 2:7 scripture tells us that God "breathed the breath of life into us." But without the vowels we added to form the name Yahweh, have you ever considered that, when we inhale and exhale a breath, it sounds like we are saying YHWH?

Caporale's hypothesis is that with every breath, we are speaking the name of God, with a baby's first breath, a sigh or a groan, we are giving our God constant acknowledgement and praise all the way to our very last breath!

Ezra opened the book in sight of all the people and he blesses the Lord. In response the crowd stands, and all the people answer, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting their hands. There it is: lifting holy hands without wrath and doubting. David talked about the raising of hands. Paul also spoke of these words. And now, as the dedication is taking place, we see it happening again. This comes directly from Nehemiah 8:6, Then Ezra praised the Lord, the great God, and all the people chanted, "Amen! Amen!" as they lifted their hands. Then they bowed down and worshiped the Lord with their faces to the ground. (NLT) That's yet another picture of how to worship, to bow before the Lord. To worship is to give deference, to give respect to the Lord, whether you're alone, at a dedication ceremony, or in a meeting with 5,000 people. 

NEWS YOU NEED TO KNOW...



Welcome to Planning Center Online



We are so excited to introduce Planning Center Online (PCO) to you this year. We will utilize PCO for all of our concert scheduling and registrations as well as storing and sharing all our music charts and recordings for the year. PCO is an incredibly powerful tool that will enable us to share information more readily.

Registering for Concerts of Worship and other Events

For each event, everyone will receive a scheduling request via email. At the bottom of that email are two links, one to "Accept" and one to "Decline" the request from PCO. If you plan on attending the concert/event, please accept the request, and if you cannot attend, please decline the request. When you "Accept," you are counted for two very important reasons: the Meal before the concert and to let us know how many are coming in each section and the orchestra. By doing so, the host church can best prepare for our arrival. The deadline for being included in the meal count is by NOON on the Monday BEFORE the event. Please help us help our hosts by replying promptly.

Scheduling emails are sent out from PCO two weeks prior to the concert. If you are NOT receiving these email requests, please do the following: 1) check your junk/spam folder as these emails may end up there, 2) log in to PCO and ensure that you are checking the right email account, 3) if neither of the two previous options help, contact Shelly Chandler at the ABSC for assistance. schandler@absc.org

Acquiring Music Files

Music charts and recordings will no longer be available on the Master'Singers website. All of these tasks will now be included in your PCO account. To view the files, you must go to the "SERVICE" (concert) in which you are scheduled to sing/play.

Once you accept your invitation, if you are viewing the service on your computer (not your smart phone or tablet), select the service in the "PLANS" tab at the top. On the right hand side of each song in the order of service, select the gray box with the number in it to access each song's files.

Music Stand App

If you have a tablet you can use PCO's Music stand App. It is available for free in the App Stores for free for both Apple and Android devices. To access the music for each concert/service, simply log in to Music Stand with your PCO credentials (see below). You can then navigate to the particular Service (concert) and your music will be in order and ready for you to view. This works with both singers and instrumentalists.

Forgot Your Login?

If you have forgotten your PCO login, simply click the "Need a password?" link on the PCO login page. Enter the email address that you use to log in, and PCO will send you a password reset email.

Updating Your Information

Be sure to take some time to update your contact information in PCO so that our database is correct.

- 1. Log in to PCO and click your name in the upper right portion of the screen and select "Profile"
- 2. Once you are in the profile section, click "Edit" next to your name and enter any updated info.
- 3. Click "Save"
- 4. If you do not have a profile picture, click on the silhouette next to your name and upload one.
